# Climate Commons

The Climate Commons is a **digital library of climate science** and guidance for applying it to conservation in California. All CA LCC project deliverables can be found in the Commons.

In 2015 Climate Commons **accomplishments** include:

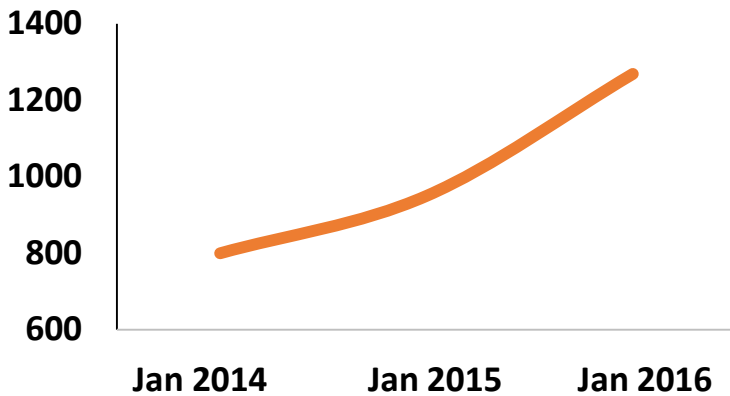
- 44,000 page views
- 126 new data download accounts– total is now over 450
- 726 data layers downloaded by 95 distinct users
- 166 new library catalog records (documents, datasets, websites)
- 13 new and 28 updated “Get Started” articles about climate science
- Several new hosted climate model datasets
- Many updates to overall design
